Students will apply for these courses once they arrive at UAM through an online form. What is the min. and max. course load? Minimum is 10 ECTS per semester, 20 ECTS per academic year. Maximum is 30 ECTS per semester, 60 ECTS per academic year. How do students need to register for the courses? Students need to reserve their spot online through the course selection website during July (Fall Semester & Full Academic year students) or December (Spring Semester students). Are Master's courses available? Only to Master's students and upon request after arrival at UAM. Not granted.
