### Part B. CV SUMMARY

PhD in Economics from the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid, with the doctoral thesis: *The influence of collective bargaining on the macroeconomic results of the European Union* (2004). Lecturer in the Department of Economic Structure and Development Economics at the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid, where she has been the Academic Secretary since 2017. From 2019 to 2023 she was the Delegate of the Dean for Communication and Social Networks. She teaches postgraduate lessons in University Master's Degree in Economic Development and Public Policies and University Master's Degree in Interdisciplinary Gender Studies, where she has been coordinator since September 2023.

Member of the [SET-LASE](#) research group on Labour Socio-Economics and the [FEMGEN](#) research group focused on Interdisciplinary Gender Studies and Feminist Theory. She has been the coordinator of several projects on teaching innovation, and she was awarded the *Excellence Teaching Award* 2018 and 2021 (Universidad Autónoma de Madrid, Spain).



Socio and Labor Economics, particularly labour market institutions, collective bargaining, quality of employment and decent work, and gender economics, are her research lines of work.

She participated in several projects about labour market institutions (like *Socio-labour transitions in the digital era: occupational change, labour segmentation and wage inequality*, *Labour Market Institutions and crisis: tendencies and transformations*, or *Internal flexibility instruments in Collective Bargaining*), publishing the results in books and peer-reviewed journals (*Economics-The Open-Access*, 2019; *Instituciones Laborales en Europa*, 2019, Ed. Tirant lo Blanch, and *Instrumentos de flexibilidad interna en la negociación colectiva*, 2012, Ed. Ministerio de Empleo y Seguridad Social).

Another field of interest is gender perspective on the quality of employment, with works presented at several congresses (ILO-Seville, Department of Employment, Madrid; ILO-Geneve; SASE-Kyoto) and published in peer-reviewed journals (*Regional and Sectoral Economic Studies*).

She recently worked on how new technologies and ITC skills impact employment, published a relevant article on *Telematics and Informatics*, co-led a transfer project with Fundación Alternativas about digitalisation and the future of work, presented at international meetings (ILERA, SASE). Related to that, she led a project on *Transformation in the quality of employment of women and men in the face of digitalization within the framework of the SDGs* funded by the Women's Institute, of the Ministry of Equality during 2023.

She has edited several books (*Economic Policies for Development: Beyond the Millennium Goals*, 2020, Nova Science Publishers, *Integración y desarrollo: miradas desde América Latina y Europa (1997-2017)*, 2022, Ediciones UAM).

During recent years expanded divulgation skills by participating in different talks, seminars and workshops (both with physical presence and online).
