
CALL FOR PROPOSALS

II PRICIT Doctoral Workshop

We welcome Ph.D. proposals to the 2022 PRICIT¹ Doctoral Workshop. This Workshop is jointly organized with the ASEPUC financial reporting network, and will be held on 31 March and 1 April 2022, hosted by [Universitat Jaume I](#), in Castellón (Spain).

The PRICIT Doctoral Workshop provides a platform for doctoral students to present their research on accounting topics including (but not limited to) financial accounting, auditing, corporate governance, accounting history, environmental accounting, or management accounting. The Workshop offers doctoral students an opportunity to present, discuss, receive feedback, and exchange comments and views in an inspiring academic community of fellow Spanish Ph.D. students and experienced researchers. This is also an opportunity to build academic relationships. This second edition will be PRESENTIAL (face to face).

The Doctoral Workshop calls all interested doctoral candidates to submit their research proposals for review and feedback. The research proposals should typically include the following structure:

- Introduction/problem statement/definition.
- Brief literature review.
- Conceptual development.
- Proposed methodology.
- Outcome/anticipated results.

Each submission will undergo a review process. Both early-stage ideas and more advanced projects are welcome, but they should be sufficiently developed such that feedback can be useful.

The Doctoral Workshop also offers two keynote discussions, and an opportunity to gain mentorship on devising the most effective strategy for writing and submitting papers to leading Journals.

The workshop is free of charge.

It is possible to attend the doctoral workshop without submitting a proposal. Doctoral students in very early stages, who have not yet developed a proposal, are also welcome and encouraged to attend.

Financial aid and best proposal awards

For those students who submit a proposal and are accepted for presentation, the committee offers some funds to support exclusively travel and accommodation expenses, up to a maximum of 150 euros per person. Detailed instructions on how to reimburse expenses will be sent individually to those students who receive financial support. Please make sure, when you submit the paper, that you apply for financial support explicitly by requesting it.

We are also delighted to announce that, in this edition, the *Ciutat de Castelló* Professorship sponsors one award of 650 euros and two of 350 euros for the best proposals presented.
