b. Estructura y contenido.

This doctoral webinar series is structured as an annual event and showcases the ground-breaking work conducted by CIVIS faculty connected to Digital and Technological Transformations (DTT).

One Friday per month we will have an online session, with speakers of different CIVIS Universities, in relation to Challenges of Digital and Technological Transformations. The series closes with a round-table discussion with all participating speakers.

The focus of each annual series changes, allowing doctoral researchers and postgraduate students to participate in each edition of the webinar. The 2024-25 edition will take a critical look at how DTT is transforming work, organizational life and individual's life and labor projects. We will take a case study approach to the series in which leading researchers examine and unpack specific work and institutional scenarios that are being reshaped by changing technological and digital infrastructures. The outlook of the cases will be broad and includes examples of planned optimization of organizational environments at various scales but also new forms of work precarity and uncertainty generated by DTT.
