STATEMENT: THE EARLY MEDIEVAL CHINA GROUP (EMC GROUP) IS AN INFORMAL ACADEMIC GROUP OF YOUNG, PREDOMINANTLY EUROPEAN RESEARCHERS WHO IN THE PAST HAVE GATHERED ON AN IRREGULAR BASIS AT EUROPEAN UNIVERSITIES TO SHARE THEIR RESEARCH ON TOPICS RELATED TO THE EARLY MEDIEVAL PERIOD OF CHINESE. HISTORY. SINCE ITS FIRST MEETING IN 2014 AT THE PALACKÝ UNIVERSITY IN OLOMOUC, CZECH REPUBLIC, WHERE ONLY SIX RESEARCHERS PARTICIPATED, THE GROUP HAS EXPANDED IN THE LAST YEARS TO INCLUDE TWENTY SCHOLARS. THE EMC WORKSHOP IS CHARACTERIZED BY ITS INTERDISCIPLINARY NATURE: WITHIN THE CHRONOLOGICALLY-DEFINED FRAMEWORK OF EARLY MEDIEVAL CHINA THE MEETING WILL BRING TOGETHER RESEARCH BASED ON MATERIAL CULTURE, ON LITERARY SOURCES, ON HISTORIOGRAPHICAL MATERIALS, AND OTHERS, APPLYING A WIDE RANGE OF RESEARCH METHODS. THE FORMAT OF THE WORKSHOP WILL HELP TO FACILITATE THE TRANSFERENCE OF KNOWLEDGE: PAPERS WILL BE PREVIOUSLY CIRCULATED AND CRITICALLY ASSESSED BY A DISCUSSANT. ALSO, THE EMC WORKSHOP WILL BE A MILESTONE IN THE INSTITUTIONALIZATION PROCESS OF THE EMC GROUP AS A CONSOLIDATED PLATFORM FOR THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF EUROPE-CENTRED RESEARCH ON THE EARLY MEDIEVAL PERIOD OF CHINESE HISTORY.
