Important Course Enrollment notes	Exchange students are not permitted to take courses virtually at YorkU from overseas.  Exchange students should ensure return flights are arranged to accommodate the end of the examination period. Most courses require students to be present in Toronto for examinations.  Exchange students will enroll into courses online. If courses are reserved or restricted, exchange students may seek permission from the course department to add the course. Students may be required to provide additional information proving they meet course prerequisites. Permission to enroll may not be granted. At times, students must wait up to 2 weeks prior to semester start date to begin
	enrolling.

#### **IMMIGRATION & PROVINCIAL ATTESTATION LETTERS**

Exchange students are responsible for understanding the immigration regulations and timelines to obtain the necessary documents for their travel to Canada. Students can contact the Canadian consular office or speak with one of the York registered immigration advisors for more information. Students on exchange to York University for one semester (less than 6 months) will not require a Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL). Students who have received special authorization to study for two semesters (more than 6 months) will be issued a PAL along with the admission letter. Questions?
