### ABOUT US

National Taipei University of Business (NTUB) was founded over a century ago in 1917. It is the only university in Taiwan to focus exclusively on business-related studies. The university comprises thirteen departments within four colleges located on two campuses. The main campus is in the urban heart of Taipei, only one subway stop away from Taipei Main Station. Myriad eating and entertainment options are nearby. The Colleges of Management, Business, and International Marketing are located on the Taipei campus. The rural Taoyuan campus, half an hour drive from Taoyuan International Airport, is home to the College of Innovative Design and Management.



## Academic Information

- All Exchange Program courses are at the Taipei campus.
- Open to undergraduate and graduate students.
- All exchange students must take Basic Chinese (3 credits) and Cross-cultural service learning (2 credits). Minimum of 4 credit hours required for a subsequent exchange semester.
- Language Proficiency Requirements:
  - English** We do not require an official language certificate. However, all Exchange Program courses are taught in English. Students may also take English-taught courses in other departments with the instructor's permission. The availability of these courses varies each semester.
  - Mandarin Chinese** Students whose native language is Mandarin Chinese or those who have achieved the equivalent of TOCFL Band B Level 3, HSK 5, or equivalent are welcome to choose from our Chinese-taught courses in all departments.

## Practical Information



Acceptance letters will be sent by E-mail. Students may download it and send it to their home university if needed. Original letters will be sent by post upon request.



The Office of International Affairs will hold an orientation session in the week before the semester starts. This is a crucial part of the exchange. It allows students a smooth start in their stay at NTUB and in Taiwan.



It is very important to ensure you are fully insured before studying abroad in Taiwan. All students are required to purchase insurance that covers accident and medical insurance during their stay in Taiwan. We strongly recommend that insurance plans be worth a minimum of NT\$2,000,000 (approx. US\$66,000).

## Housing

### Dormitories

- Applications for shared NTUB dormitories can be filled in using the online form. Please note, these dormitories are not campus. Travel time between the dormitory and NTUB main campus is at least 30 minutes by subway (MRT). Please carefully consider this condition before applying.
- Considering the size of the room and the services provided, the price may vary between NT\$3,800 and NT\$6,000 (approx. US\$125 and US\$200) per month. Rental contracts in the dormitories are always for the entire duration of the official exchange semester (6 months). NON-REFUNDABLE for early checkout.

### Self-arranged accommodation

- Taipei City is a very popular international travel destination, so it's not too hard to find a place to live. However, it may take some time and effort to find something that matches your preferences. We urge you to start looking for a room or Airbnb preferably 2-3 months before you arrive in Taipei.
